## 6 Months

Hepatitis B: Dose 3 <sup>3</sup>  
Rotavirus: Dose 3 <sup>4</sup>  
DTaP: Dose 3  
Hib: Dose 3 <sup>4</sup>  
Pneumococcal: Dose 3  
Polio: Dose 3 <sup>3</sup>  
Flu <sup>5</sup>

## 12-15 Months

Hib: Dose 4  
Pneumococcal: Dose 4  
MMR: Dose 1  
Chickenpox: Dose 1  
Hepatitis A <sup>6</sup>

## 15-18 Months

DTaP: Dose 4

## 4-6 years

DTaP: Dose 5  
Polio: Dose 4  
MMR: Dose 2  
Chickenpox: Dose 2
